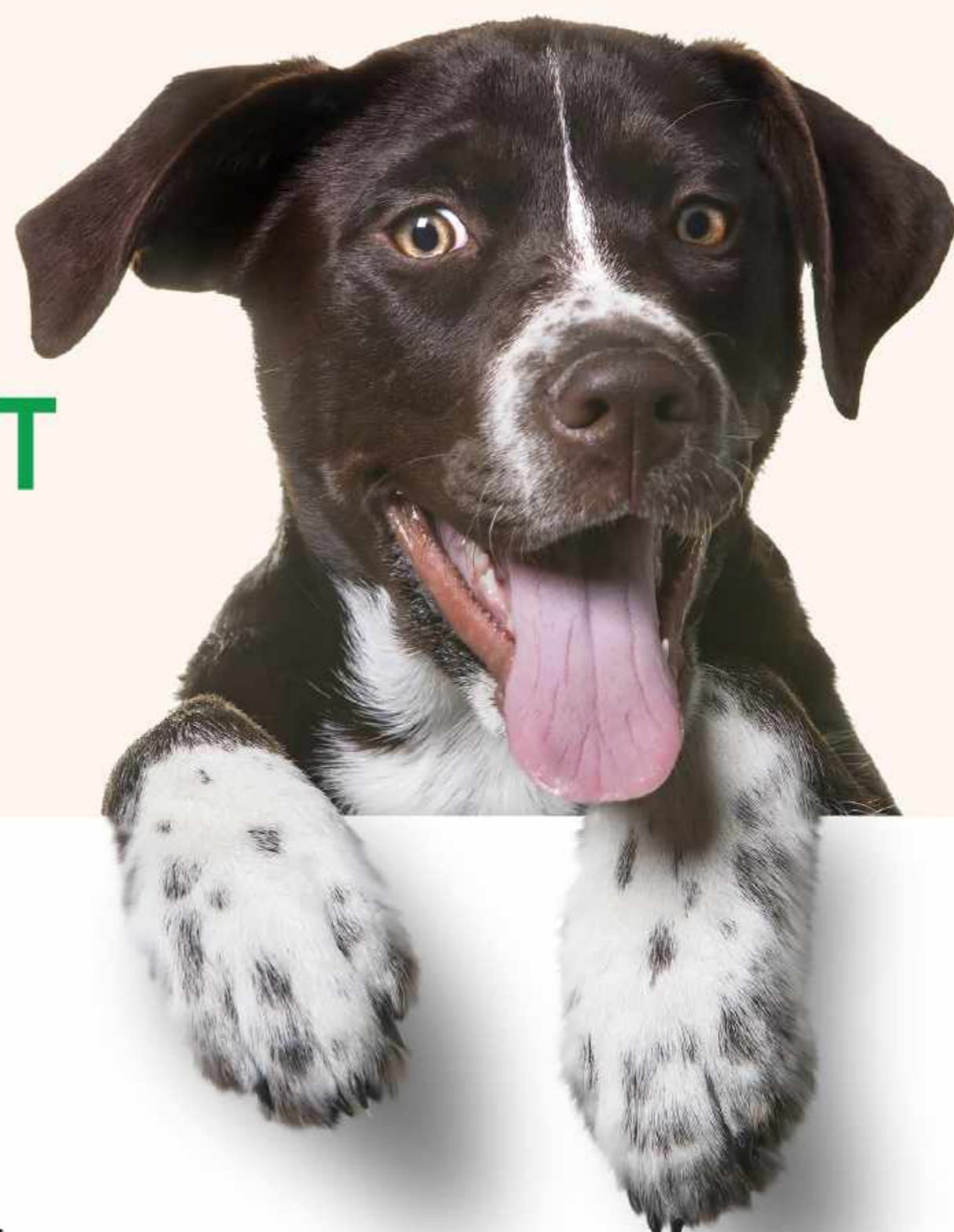

PET FIRST AID KIT CHECKLIST



Pet First Aid Kit

Here is what to include in a pet first aid kit.

- Emergency numbers, including numbers for your veterinarian and animal poison control
- Leash and collar
- Hand sanitizer and liquid dishwashing fluid for bathing
- Ice pack
- Rubber gloves
- Gauze/strips of clean cloth (non-stick) and bandages (be sure to include a long Ace or similar bandage to help cover wounds on the chest or stomach of bigger dogs)
- Cotton-tipped swabs
- Adhesive tape
- Clean towels
- Over-the-counter antibiotic ointment
- Alcohol wipes
- Artificial tear gel and saline solution for the eyes
- Turkey baster or oral syringe

Find a Place to Put Your Kit

At home, your first aid kit should be in an easy-to-find, readily accessible location and clearly marked as a "Pet First Aid Kit." Next to the door where you can easily grab it or near your pet's food or other toys and possessions are good places.

Home With the Family

Some items in your first aid kit may expire over time and should be regularly replaced. Similarly, if you use your kit for any reason, it's important to replenish any items that were used.
